REGISTRATION POLICIES

THINGS TO REMEMBER:

- Classes begin the week of June 6.
- Registration begins May 13.
- Registration confirmations are not sent. Please keep a record of dates and times of your classes.
- Register early to avoid cancellations due to low enrollment.
- Contact CityArts to verify class will take place before purchasing supplies.

Cancellations:

- If a class is cancelled due to low enrollment, you will be notified by phone prior to the class start date and given transfer or refund options.
- If you withdraw from a class, you must call 48 hours prior to the start date. You may choose to transfer to another class or request a refund.

Refund Policy:

- CityArts will fully refund cancelled classes.
- Allow three weeks to receive refund.

If you withdraw:

- Two days prior to the first class: 80 percent refund
- Two days after second class: 50 percent refund
- No refunds after third class

Late Registration:

- Late registration allowed if space is available and it does not impact the students' learning process.
- Classes will be pro-rated after the second week.
